

DIEGUEÑO MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS CODE

Clothes worn to school should be appropriate for school activities. The following is a list of apparel guidelines that are not allowed at school. When violation of the dress code occurs, the student will be required to return home for proper attire, have clothing brought from home to school, or wear their P.E clothes. Continued violations of the dress code will be considered defiance and will be referred to the assistant principal for disciplinary action.

1. Clothing that advertises, promotes or glamorizes violence, defiance, weapons, drugs alcohol or tobacco products, gang affiliation and clothing that displays foul or sexually suggestive language or symbols is not permitted.
2. Shoes must be worn at all times. Reminder, rubber flip-flops and high heeled open toed shoes may not be safe to wear. Roller skate shoes and slippers are not allowed on campus.
3. Pants must fit at the waist. Undergarments must not show.
4. Shorts, skorts, skirts, and dresses may not be shorter than mid thigh.
5. Cut off shirts, clothing that is too skimpy or revealing including low v-neck shirts, bathing suits, tube tops, and tops that are strapless, have one shoulder strap, are see-through, low cut, or backless **are not permitted**. Tops that expose the midriff may not be worn, even under jackets. **All shirts must meet the top of students' pants/skirts.**
6. Chains of any kind, spiked apparel, safety pins are not permitted.
7. Hats are permitted on campus but must be taken off inside classrooms. Hats may not advertise violence, drugs, alcohol or tobacco and may not denote any gang affiliation. Hats and sweatshirt hoods are never to be worn in a classroom. Bandanas **are not permitted on campus.**
