

Dear Diegueno Families,

California's academic standards—the things we want students to know and be able to do—are designed so students graduate ready for college and a career. One way we measure their progress is through the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) assessments. Students across California in grades 3–8 and high school take these assessments each spring.

Diegueno students will take these assessments in their regularly scheduled English classes on May 2-5, and in their Math classes May 9-12. Students in 8th grade will take the pilot of our Science assessment on May 16th or 17th in their science classes.

- Students will need headphones for the audio portion of these assessments. We have headphones that we provide, however, in our experience, students seem to prefer to bring their own earbuds. This is absolutely fine, as long as they are the kind that can be plugged in.

- Remember to get a good night's sleep before testing, and to eat breakfast!
- Finally, students are encouraged to bring a book, or something to study should they finish testing early.
