A. History/Social Science	2 Years Required
B. English	4 Years Required
C. Mathematics	3 Years Required
D. Lab Science	2 Years Required
E. Language other than English	2 Years Required
F. Visual and Performing Art (VPA)	1 Year Required
G. College Preparatory Elective	1 Year Required

All courses must be completed with a 'C' grade or higher

What you can do NOW to best prepare for high school

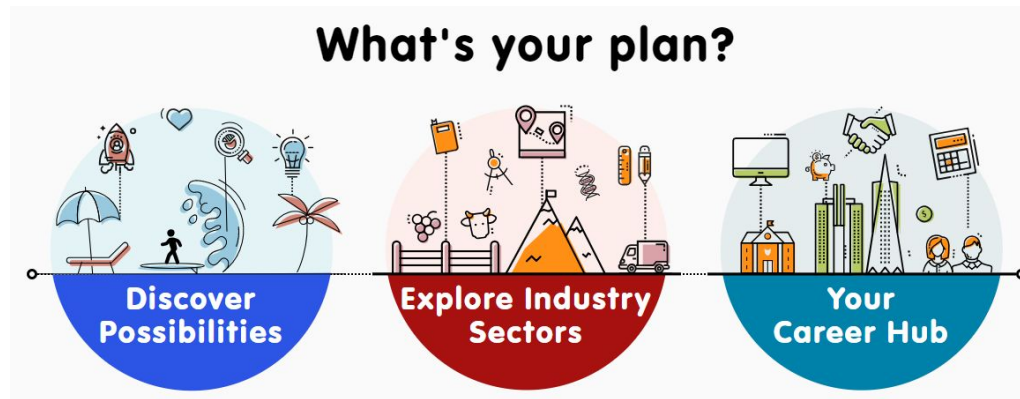
- **Be here every day on time and ready to learn.**
