<u>Bike Info!</u>

- Fill out an <u>application</u> and turn it into the office with Ms. Mallory <u>mallory.reeves@sduhsd.net</u> (there is a box on the counter to drop it in!)
- EVERYONE MUST TURN IN A NEW APPLICATION EVERY YEAR!
- Provide proof of a bike safety class
 - 8th graders: if you took a bike safety course last year, it will transfer! No need to show proof of class
- Bike Tag distribution will begin on Late Start 9/23
 - 8th graders: you will need to receive a new tag for the new school year
- All bikes must be tagged by Friday 10/4
