- All CA students in grades 3-8 and 11 take the Smarter Balanced Assessments (SBAC) in English & Math.
- 8th graders will take the CAST test in Science.
- This is your chance to show how much you have grown academically over the last 3 years.
- May 7-10 English
- May 14-17 Math
- May 21-24 Science

Dress for Success

Clothing & backpacks are NOT permitted that:

- Advertise alcohol, drugs, or tobacco.
- Discriminate against anyone (Race, gender identity, sexual orientation, religion, national origin, disability, ANYTHING!)
- Advertise or promote gang affiliation

Revealing clothing is not permitted.

NO: Muscle shirts, strapless tops, halter tops, see-through tops, tops that expose the midriff, backless tops, off-the-shoulder tops.

Dress for Success

- Skirts & dresses are to be fingertip length.
- Shorts are to be length of a closed fist.
- Pants & shorts are to be secured at the waist: no dangling belts or sagging pants.
- Footwear must be worn on campus.
- Remove hats/beanies/hoods inside.
- Wallet chains & bandannas are not allowed.

Student appearance in any way (make up, hair, jewelry, or piercings) may not cause distractions or safety concerns to any student or the school environment.
